2009 MUNICIPAL GENERAL ELECTION

Election Date: Monday, 2 November, 2009. Hours: 9:00am to 7:00pm

CRITERIA TO BE AN ELIGIBLE ELECTOR

An individual is considered an eligible elector when they are:

- (a) not less than eighteen years of age
- (b) a Canadian citizen; and
- (c) a resident in the municipality for a period of six months preceding the date of the election.

CRITERIA TO BE AN ELIGIBLE CANDIDATE FOR MAYOR OR TOWN COUNCIL

To be eligible to run as a candidate, an individual must be:

- (a) Not less than 18 years of age;
- (b) A Canadian citizen; and
- (c) A resident of the Town for a period of one year preceding the date of nominations.
