

**APPROVED MINUTES FROM SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING
HELD JULY 17, 2006 AT 1:10 P.M.**

A special Council meeting was held July 17, 2006 at 1:10 p.m. with Mayor Murphy presiding and Councillors Adams, Curtis and Jeffery present.

Mayor Murphy said the purpose of the meeting was to discuss purchasing the Presbyterian manse and a request for an extension to Argyle Street.

The motion was made by Councillor Curtis, seconded by Councillor Adams that we put a bid in on the Presbyterian manse and land with two conditions that the deed is clear to provide access to the former Campbell land and also depends on the vote of the whole council.

The motion was tabled until the next meeting.

The motion was made by Councillor Jeffery, seconded by Councillor Adams and carried to open Argyle Street approximately 170 feet at the best possible cost and future streets be opened on a case by case basis.

A special council meeting will be held July 24th at 7:00 p.m. to discuss the purchase of the manse and property.

The motion was made by Councillor Jeffery that the meeting be adjourned.
