**The motion was made by Councillor Campbell, seconded by Councillor Pottier and carried for the approval of the agenda.**

**The motion was made by Councillor Curtis, seconded by Councillor Cahill and carried for the approval of the minutes from the regular council meeting held June 14, 2010.**

**BUSINESS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES**

Councillor Campbell asked to check regulations on sidewalks and if it is 8 feet from the edge of the asphalt.

**CORRESPONDENCE**

**BUSINESS LICENCES AND/OR BUILDING PERMITS**

**The motion was made by Councillor Cahill, seconded by Councillor Gillis and carried to abandon the sewer easement on Holland College land.**

**The motion was made by Councillor Cahill, seconded by Councillor Pottier and carried to approve a fence 8'6" for property tax number 447524-000 located at 641 Main Street.**

**The motion was made by Councillor Cahill, seconded by Councillor Gillis and carried to approve a fence 6.5 feet for property tax number 18879-000 located at 386 Main Street.**

An application from Alan Shaw for a subdivision will be sent to government departments.

## COMMITTEE REPORTS

Councillor Gallant reported for recreation. Soccer is doing well. Zachery secured \$1000.00 sponsorship for the Girls team from Kent. Canada Day went well. Alberton Day is planned and the theme is Automotive Heritage Week. The recreation department will have a parade in Alberton Exhibition. Councillor Gallant said we will be looking for the biggest tree in Alberton for the challenge.

Councillor Campbell reported for environment. The sewer bills are sent out and by fall we may have to clean up any in arrears. He also reported everyday maintenance is being done.

Councillor Gillis reported for fire. The fire report was distributed. There were 74 calls to date this year. The annual Show & Shine Car Show will be held in August. Councillor Gillis reported that in September a major vehicle extraction course will be held at the fire hall.

Councillor Curtis reported for police. There were 32 foot patrols.

Councillor Pottier reported for tourism and property. The West Prince Tourism Association has a student doing a weekly round up of events.

Councillor Cahill reported for finance and streets. Councillor Cahill said we have been waiting to find out about sidewalk work. He suggested we get prices on resurfacing Argyle Street between Main & Dufferin Streets.

Councillor Pottier returned to the meeting.

**The motion was made by Councillor Cahill, seconded by Councillor Gillis and carried to make J.C. Arena parking lot priority #2 for the Island Community Fund.**

Councillor Pottier requested pedestrian traffic signs on Church Street towards O'Brien Drive.
