The motion was made by Councillor Gillis, seconded by Councillor Cahill and carried for the approval of the agenda with the addition of committee of the whole.

The motion was made by Councillor Gillis, seconded by Councillor Campbell and carried for the approval of the minutes of the regular council meeting held August 9, 2010.

CORRESPONDENCE

The motion was made by Councillor Cahill, seconded by Pottier and carried to approve an ad for the Journal Pioneer to salute the volunteer firefighters for \$53.00 plus GST.

A letter was received from Hon. Doug Currie in response to a request for provincial funding for municipal fire service. It will be brought to the joint council meeting.

A letter from Family Violence will be put on hold until budget.

The motion was made by Councillor Gillis, seconded by Councillor Cahill and carried to approve a property development application for a 6 unit apartment for PID #19315 on MacNeill Lane.

The motion was made Councillor Gillis, seconded by Councillor Pottier and carried to approve a property development application for a self storage building for PID #1005818-000 on Argyle Street.

The motion was made by Councillor Campbell, seconded by Councillor Gillis and carried to approve a property development application for interior renovations to PID # 744193 located at 555 Main Street.

A property development application received for a wind turbine and tower for PID # 31062 located at 349 Church Street was put on hold for more information.

A property development application was received for an addition of 1,000 square foot to PID # 30411 at 455 Main Street.

The motion was made by Councillor Gillis, seconded by Councillor Cahill and carried to shelf the permit until more information is obtained.

A property development application was received for renovations and a 20 feet X 20 feet addition to PID # 30163 located at 480 Main Street.

The motion was made by Councillor Campbell, seconded by Councillor Pottier and carried to shelf the permit until a survey is done.

Councillor Gallant reported for recreation. The Terry Fox Run is September 19th at 2:30 P.M. The ball programs are finished. Zachery is finished in the next couple of weeks.

Councillor Campbell reported for environment. The sewer project is starting on Wednesday. Sewer money is coming in but there is more to come.

Councillor Gillis had nothing to report for fire.

The motion was made by Councillor Gillis, seconded by Councillor Campbell and carried to send a letter to Honourable Gail Shea concerning the funding cut for Katimavik.

The RCMP officer gave the police report in the absence of Councillor Curtis. During the month of August the members spent 237 hours policing the town and responded to 18 calls for service and conducted 44 foot patrols.

Councillor Pottier reported for Tourism and Property. Councillor Pottier said it would soon be time to submit advertising for the North Cape Coastal Drive and she would like to see a message from the Mayor. She also said there should be a small ad for the PEI handbook.

The motion was made by Councillor Cahill, seconded by Councillor Gillis and carried to pay bills in amount of \$29,296.71.
