Councillor Curtis returned to the meeting and Mayor Murphy and Councillor Pottier left the meeting due to a conflict of interest.

Deputy Mayor Gallant took over the chair.

The motion was made by Councillor Cahill, seconded by Councillor Campbell and carried to give Alberton and Area Development Corporation a grant in the amount of \$1,500.00.

The motion was made by Councillor Cahill, seconded by Councillor Gillis and carried to adjourn the meeting.
