

**APPROVED MINUTES FROM SPECIAL COUNCIL
HELD WEDNESDAY, MAY 29, 2013 AT 7:30 P.M.**

A special council meeting was held Wednesday, May 29, 2013 at 7:30 p.m. with Mayor Murphy presiding and all councillors present also staff Susan Wallace-Flynn.

The purpose of the meeting was to explain that the motion made at the May 13, 2013 meeting **that the Mayor meet with the “Career Development Services Inc.” tomorrow morning and sign the contract allowing the first person to be hired and the Town fund our portion but continue to source sponsorship for all or part of the cost and that the Town negotiate an agreement to hire the second person to succeed the first person,** the deal fell through and the contract went to the Community of O’Leary.

Councillor Duggan said he negotiated with the Community of O’Leary for a contract 2 days per week for 16 hours per week at \$7.00 per hour plus mandatory employment costs including vacation pay and Workers Compensation for the student.

A contract from the Community of O’Leary was reviewed by council and they requested that the following items be changed in the contract –

- Remove the section that states “That his duties include responsibilities connected to the Under 16 Girls Nationals tournament.”
- Clarification on the mileage
- The section that states “the Western Regional Sports Council will be responsible for managing this employee and providing supervision while located in Alberton” should state Management Committee.

Councillor Duggan said he had a task list prepared for the student but did not have a copy with him.

Council discussed a list of requests for funding and the motions will be made at the next regular council meeting, also the groups will be advised that the grants may be cut further next year.

The motion was made by Councillor Duggan, seconded by Councillor Cahill and carried to enter into an agreement with the Community of O’Leary to hire the employee for 16 hours per week and the Mayor negotiate for the above requirements for the contract as requested by council and perform the task list to be attached to the contract.

Councillor Duggan left the meeting due to work commitments.

The motion was made by Councillor Gallant, seconded by Councillor Pottier and carried to adjourn the meeting.
